### **Oxford University Challenge Seed Fund**

- Launched 1999 with £4m (£1m OU)
- Contributors UK Government, Wellcome Trust and Gatsby Foundation
- Over £9m invested in 162 projects
- One of the few UCSF funds still running in its original form
- 42 spinouts created

#### **University of Oxford Innovation Fund**

- EIS/SEIS funds for investors managed by Parkwalk Advisors
- Oxford University Innovation is Portfolio Advisor
- Funds 1 & 2 (£1.25m & £1.75m) fully committed, 3<sup>rd</sup> fund now being distributed





#### **Oxford Invention Fund**

- Launched in 2010 with £1.5m
- Donate to support development of new technologies from Oxford
- Donations from University, alumni and Johnson & Johnson
- Over £2.5m invested in 42 projects
- 11 spinouts created




